The following skills will be assessed:

1. Theme Vocabulary: radiation, transfer, connect, reassured, ingredients, scientific, conduction, convection, chemical, molecules
  - a. You need to know how to use the words in sentences
  - b. You will need to be able to match the definition and the word
2. Long Vowels
  - a. Some words end in a long vowel, consonant, and a silent e. The silent e at the end of the word causes the long vowel sound (a, e, i, o, u).
  - b. be able to identify beginning and ending consonant blends
3. Nouns
  - a. names a person, place, thing, or idea
  - b. common nouns refer to general persons, places, thing, or ideas-->such as
  - c. proper nouns refer to a specific person, place, or thing, and begins with a capital letter

Be able to identify the word family word is in and select words that belong to the same word family.

4. Asking Questions
  - a. This is a comprehension skill we are developing. Asking questions keeps you thinking about your reading. Asking questions before you read will help you make predictions about what you are going to read. Asking questions during and after your reading will help you understand the material better.
  - b. be able to read a passage and ask questions based on the clues provided in the passage
